June PAL Meeting

The June PAL meeting will be held Tuesday, June 5th at The Arts Building, 808 Lincoln Way in Auburn at 10:00 AM. Our demonstrating artist is nationally-known sculptor, Deanna Marsh. Creating landscape sculptures of steel and kiln-formed glass, Deanna interprets the imagery of water into her sculptural forms, from the ancient canyons and mountain ranges of the West, to the natural beauty of her studio above the American River.

"Within each sculpture, I am building a dialogue between ancient and modern materials-minerals or fossils and modern steel and glass - old geologic forces and newer man-made materials," she says. "My goal is to awaken an environmental activism within each of us by an informed view of the mystery and majesty of

the natural world - to reignite that critical and harmonious relationship that is often removed from daily life." Deanna often studies topographic maps and satellite imagery. This elevated view carries spiritual overtones for her of the humble scale of man relative to our greater world.

Artist of the Month: Autumn Moon

Our Artist of the Month for June is Autumn Moon. She's a relatively new member of PAL, although she has entered the PAL Open Juried Show in the past -- winning the first place ribbon for a clay piece last year, with her friend Mike Daley.

Autumn's first clay class was taught at a museum in W. Palm Beach, Florida when she was a child. After the class was over, much to her surprise, the museum bought her artwork! Quite an auspicious beginning, we'd say.

Family has taken her away from artistic pursuits for the past few years, and she's enjoying getting her hands back into clay again. She credits Lincoln Hills clay instructors Dick Kettelle and Terry Accomando with getting her started again, with inspiration from our own Tommie Moller. Autumn currently enjoys a creative partnership with local potter Mike Daley. "He throws the pots and I embellish them," she says.

Some of Autumn's favorite subjects are fanciful in nature . . . dragons and whimsical horses, for instance. "My two grandsons wanted me to make them dragons," she says. "They love the results!" Right now, she's working on some bas relief pots with Mike Daly and some on her own, stretching her skills and creativity to new limits.
