Classes and Education for Professionals

Printmaking Class, Noel Sandino teaches this small group class in basic Monotype printmaking and variations which includes drypoint and collograph. Monotype is called the painterly print in which inks are applied and manipulated a plate to create lovely effects. Then with the use of an etching press, the image transferred to paper. We use a plexiglass plate as our printing base and non-tox inks to start with. No need to bring any supplies to the first session. Students decide what they want to purchase after that. Class will be held Thursday evenings, 5:30-8pm, July 21st, 2016 through August 25th, 2016. Fee is \$106. Please link [here for more information](#).

Beginning Clay Slip Printmaking, in this workshop, **Noel Sandino** teaches students how to make colorful prints using a stoneware slab and colored clay slip apply to it for a different approach to printmaking. Prints are pulled by hand using

common tools. It is a very fun means of making prints and we use a type of stiff fabric to print onto. All supplies are included in the class fee. Bring a friend and make it more fun.
