ELIGIBILITY

Open to artists residing in Placer County

Must be 18 years or older

Artist must have completed listing in ACPC Artists Directory

Works must be original

Artists must have a body of work

All art must be gallery ready - 2D work must be wired (no Sawtooth Hangers) and Framed (in good condition)

ACPC reserves right to refuse to hang work that does not meet these standards

Artist must deliver work to venue on set-up date and pick-up artwork on take-down date

All art must be for Sale

We will be choosing many artists for this location. Depending on work compatibility and size the number of works shown will vary

Artist must complete appropriate Call-To-Artists and submit one image

ACPC reserves right to refuse to hang work that does not meet these standards or is for any reason deemed unacceptable

Submission deadline is **January 16, 2019**.

ART WORK

We will be accepting all mediums. Both 2D and 3D work will be considered. 2D must be wired to wall hang. 3D work must be professionally displayed.

NOTIFICATION

Chosen artists will be notified through **email**.

Artists must arrange Drop-off on **January 23, 2019**

between 9:30-11:00am or 5:00-6:00 pm
